
Great interest in the HealthPros Training Network worldwide!


As reported in the first Newsletter, the recruitment of the HealthPros Training Network started officially mid-January 2018 and at closure of the second deadline (31st of March) we had 150 interested applicants (we included those applying April 1st). Even after that applications came in until a total of 171, although these were not anymore included in the first selection.

All applicants were checked for eligibility by our project manager and subsequently the 1st, 2nd and 3rd choice candidates were sent to the beneficiaries. Figure 1 shows the distribution in country of birth of the applicants, while in Figure 2 the distributing in country where the MSc was obtained is shown.

A first shortlist was made and discussed, after which a total of 62 skype interviews were held. Around May/June the second shortlists were made and candidates were either invited for a second skype interview or for a face-to-face interview (both including an assignment). Currently, most applicants have been secured (or will be secured in the coming month) and we aim to have them all start in September and October 2018.
